Ohio Title II Data Dive & Higher Education Program Finder

Introduction

The Title II Higher Education Act requires each state and educator preparation program to report data annually on teacher preparation. The data found in the annual reports can help various entities understand part of the teacher supply in their state and preparation programs nationally and in each state. Title II data files are not currently available as the platform is updating the 2023 report; however, AIR staff were able to access Title II data from 2018-2019 (2020 report year) and 2019-2020 (2021 report year). This data can help district and school leaders better understand preparation data and trends in Ohio.

In breakout groups, review the Ohio data found in Exhibit 1. Look for trends in data overall and look closely at your preparation partners to understand the supply of teachers they are producing. Questions to consider as you review the data:

- What surprises you and what are the trends (if any) on the enrollment and completion numbers?
- What questions remain about the supply of teachers in Ohio?
- Does the data align with what you are hearing or seeing from programs in your area?
- How could your district utilize Title II (including when 2022 and 2023 report data are released) to assess trends over time and inform your district's approach to recruitment and hiring?
